### **NEW IMMUNIZATION LAW**

In May 2019, Governor Inslee signed House Bill 1638 which removes the personal and philosophical option to exempt children from the measles, mumps, and rubella (MMR) vaccine required for school and child care attendance. The new law will take effect on July 28, 2019.

This law will only affect those students who have a personal or philosophical

exemption to the MMR vaccine. Students with medical or religious exemptions are not affected by the new law (both of these require a doctor's signature on the exemption).

Any student not in compliance with immunization requirements will be excluded from school attendance until they can show satisfactory progress towards the requirements.
