Dear Parents/Guardians:

The faculty and staff are continuing to work and plan for a safe start to the new school year. This is an overwhelming and difficult time for families, educators, and students alike. We are striving to make the educational experience for our students rewarding, comforting, faithful, and fun.

Many new safety protocols and policies are being implemented as a result of the pandemic. The students will receive training on these new procedures when they visit on **September 10**. Please make every effort to have your child(ren) attend this important training at the specified times. We must limit the number of people in the building and the schedule is designed to accomplish that task.

- Last name beginning with A-E: 8:30-9:15
- Last name beginning with F-K: 9:30-10:15
- Last name beginning with L-O: 10:30-11:15
- Last name beginning with P-T: 12:30-1:15
- Last name beginning with U-Z: 1:30-2:15

Parents must also be trained on new protocols. This is difficult, as visitors are unable to enter the facility at this time. Please read all communication from the school and reach out if you have questions. The following items need your immediate attention:

- Daily Health Attestation- each student **must** be screened at home each day for signs/symptoms of COVID-19. The attestation form must be completed and signed each day for your child(ren) to be admitted into the building. We will send copies of this form each week, place some at our entryways, and post on our website. Please help us by completing this necessary step each morning. Students without a signed and completed form will have to return home.
- Chromebook devices will be issued to families who placed a request with the school. Our supply is limited and we must accommodate students both in the building and at home. We are trying to secure more devices to assist with needs. Any family who will be checking out a Chromebook needs to fill out the "Technology Checkout" contract and return it with your child on September 10.
- All students and parents must read and sign a "COVID-19 Acknowledgement of Risk" form. It is mandatory that all individuals read and sign this form prior to entering the building.
- Students participating in remote continuous learning are able to receive a school lunch. An order needs to be placed with your child's teacher to ensure enough meals are prepared in advance. According to Federal guidelines, a parent may pick up a meal for their child(ren) if a "Child Nutrition Program" Waiver has been signed and returned to the school.

Uniforms will be available for purchase in the school gym on September 10 from 8:30-3:30 and on September 11 from 3:00-6:00pm. Mrs. Cassie Eakle is running our Uniform Store and will be on hand to assist parents and students.

Please mark your calendars for the evening of September 30. This will be our virtual "Parent Night." Teachers will send meeting invitations to your email for you to join their presentations.


