K-8 VIRTUAL LEARNING DAY

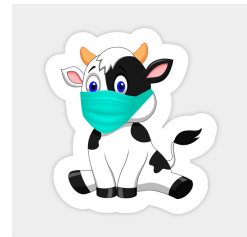
Monday, **February 22**, will be a virtual learning day for Kindergarten through 8th grade.
