Several items will require assembly so volunteer hours are available for this task. If you are willing to assist, please contact the office to schedule a time. ## FEAST OF OUR GUARDIAN ANGEL - OCTOBER 2.



Each person on earth has a guardian angel who watches over and helps us to attain our salvation. Angels are servants and messengers from God. "Angel" in Greek means messenger.
